



Statement of Carbon Neutrality

Scope 1 & Scope 2

Brother Industries (U.K.) Ltd.

has issued, on the 16th June 2026, the publicly available report:

Brother Industries (U.K.) Ltd, located at Vauxhall Industrial Estate, Ruabon, Wrexham, LL14 6HA, **declares carbon neutrality for its Scope 1 and Scope 2** greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions. This declaration is based on GHG emissions verified in accordance with **ISO 14064-1:2018** for the reporting period **1 April 2025 to 31 March 2026**, with a commitment to maintain carbon-neutral status until at least **31 March 2027**.

BSI Assurance UK Ltd has independently verified, in accordance with **ISO 14064-1:2018** and the **GHG Protocol Corporate Standard**, the GHG assertions contained within the applicable Qualifying Explanatory Statement, including:

- The methodology used by the organisation to quantify and calculate Scope 1, Scope 2 and Scope 3 GHG emissions associated with its operations during the reporting period.
- The organisation's GHG emissions reduction management plan.
- The offsetting of residual Scope 1 and Scope 2 GHG emissions through Kyoto Protocol-compliant or other accredited Voluntary Emission Reductions (VERs) generated by the following projects: Ecofiltro Clean Water & Cooking, Guatamata (GS), SELCO Solar Energy Access, India (VCSv3), Clean Power Portfolio, Global South (CDM, VCSv3)
- These offset projects are registered within the **Gold Standard Registry** or **Verra Registry**, and the corresponding carbon credits will be retired within 12 months of purchase.
